Page Four: In an essay (50 to 100 words) describe your involvement with Gelbvieh and why you have chosen this breed. Include your future plans and how Gelbvieh will be involved.

Page Five: Please attach or include letters of recommendation from one of the following people: minister, school principal, 4-H leader, FFA Instructor, county agent, teacher or active AGA adult member.

These must be included with the application and received by June 1 or your application will be disqualified.
